Supervisor Hickey reminded everyone that the Business Expo was this weekend, Saturday, March 14<sup>th</sup>, from 9:00am-1:00pm, with set up beginning at 8:00am.

Supervisor Hickey also advised the Board that the elevator in the Senior Housing Building stopped functioning briefly last week and it stopped briefly again today. The cause seemed to be a spring mechanism. He was advised that the Township should also plan to replace the circuit board in the future.

**B. TRUSTEES**

**1. Trustee Boban**

Trustee Boban reported that there will need to be a change notifying people not to bring propane containers for collection because of the problems with recycling the small household propane containers. There are private firms who recover the small amount of propane in the cylinder and handle the recycling. As of right now, the Township needs to tell people not to bring their propane containers for recycling.

Trustee Boban also noted that Lowes has donated 50 new 5 gallon containers to Sharefest for latex paint recycling and wanted to thank them in the upcoming article in the newsletter.

The new transitional student is now working on kitchen duties 1 day per week. Several previous students have jobs in the community using the skills they have learned at the Township as a training site.

Trustee Kaupas reported that the Triad meetings are growing each month with larger attendance. There will be another presentation by the Attorney General's office on scams and fraud, with next month featuring a "Grand Parents' Scam."
