

\$25,000 to \$35,000. No further discussion; Trustee Boban, Trustee Kaupas, Trustee Wennlund, Trustee Medema, and Supervisor Hickey in favor; none opposed; motion carried.

VI. REPORT FROM TOWNSHIP OFFICIALS

A. SUPERVISOR

Supervisor Hickey reported that the elevator ladders for the elevator pits were out of compliance with the recent changes in the law and suggested to the Board that these changes could be made to both. New ladders (2) could cost approximately \$2,000 each, however, an extension for both ladders could be created for \$982.00.

Motion by Trustee Medema, seconded by Trustee Wennlund, to approve \$982.00 for ladder extensions. No further discussion; Trustee Boban, Trustee Kaupas, Trustee Wennlund, Trustee Medema, and Supervisor Hickey in favor; none opposed; motion carried.

Supervisor Hickey also noted the 12 trees were removed from both Marshall and Maplewood cemetery.

B. TRUSTEES

1. Trustee Boban

Trustee Boban reported that the Mosquito Abatement program was continuing and confirmed that all areas of the Township are now being covered. He also reminded everyone that Sharefest was this coming weekend.

Trustee Boban also reminded everyone that there was only one more Saturday for paint drop offs, and as reported, there would only be a 5.5% increase for curb side pickup next year, keeping that same cost for the next 2 years.

2. Trustee Kaupas

Trustee Kaupas reported that TRIAD had another presentation for Seniors on various scams, computers, phones, and how to recognize them.

3. Trustee Wennlund

Trustee Wennlund complimented Sable Iron Works on doing a wonderful job and especially with the care taken to build-out the fence around a very large oak tree.

4. Trustee Medema

Trustee Medema noted that the falling gas prices continued to help reduce the Township's transportation costs.

C. CLERK

Clerk Boyd reminded everyone that levy reviews were approaching.

D. HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER

Highway Commissioner McPartlin presented a set of plans for the new Food Pantry for the Board to review. He reported that he had a bid opening scheduled for the Regan Road to Parker Road in order to finish the overlay. He also warned everyone that Laraway Road would be closed for 10 days by Berkots for Rail Road repairs.

E. ASSESSOR

Township Assessor Hernandez *said* that September 4th was the Board of Review Deadline

for appeals.

No further discussion; Trustee Boban, Trustee Kaupas, Trustee Wennlund, Trustee Medema and Supervisor Hickey in favor; none opposed; motion carried.
